### **Indian Head and Montmartre Detachments**

As a part of the RCMP's continuing efforts to prevent thefts, members of the Indian Head and Montmartre Detachments will be continuing to make residents aware of the necessity to secure property. In the near future, members of the detachment will be checking resident's property to ensure that they are secured properly. If property is checked by the RCMP, a business card will be left behind to notify property owners that their property was checked by the police. The business card will either thank owners for securing their property or remind them to secure their property. For example, the police will be checking to see if vehicle doors are locked and the keys are removed from them. The police will not be taking the necessary steps to secure personal property as that is the responsibility of the owners.

Over the past year, 80% to 90% of thefts that occurred in the Indian Head and Montmartre Detachment areas, were as a result of property not being secured properly. These thefts are completely preventable if the necessary steps are taken by owners.

Residents' efforts to secure their property is appreciated by the police as this prevents a lot of headaches for everyone involved.
