**Spring Clean Up:** The Village of Odessa will once again be renting a large Loraas bin for large item disposal. The bin will be located in the Village nuisance ground beginning May 25, and will be there for a minimum of 2 weeks or until it is filled. We will be open extended hours on May 25th & June 1st<sup>th</sup> from 9:00 a.m. – 12:00 p.m. This bin can be used for mattresses and other large household furniture not accepted in the burning pit. Please continue to place any metal and appliances in the metal pile, concrete in the concrete pile and gardening materials in the burning pit. We will **NOT** be accepting asphalt shingles, or any other object not accepted in the Loraas grey bins. Please contact the Village office with any questions you may have.

**Nuisance Ground Policy:**

**Acceptable Items:** Clean wood product (no paint, stain, varnish etc), tree branches, garden materials, burnable building products, Metal items/ products – Approved demolition products will be charged a dumping fee of \$20.00 per load. (Supervisor will decide what constitutes a load)

**Unacceptable Items:** Oil, oil products or waste oil, used oil filters, paint, paint cans, plastic pails, plastic items including garbage bags, pesticide containers, asbestos material, and automobile bodies, tires, and batteries, industrial or hazardous waste. All household waste must be deposited into residential grey/blue (recyclable) Loraas Bins.

**Lagoon Dumping** – 1000gal or less \$50.00 per load

**NOTICE – Bylaw No. 1/2004:** states all cats must be restrained on your property. Fines will be administered for cats running at large and cats defecating on public and/or private property. Please respect your neighbours and keep your animals confined to your property.

**Bylaw No. 3/2002:** Notice to all dog owners. The Village Office has received numerous complaints in the last couple months about dogs walking and urinating or defecating on people's private property. We request that everyone keep your dog on a leash, so you can control them easily, and to keep them from walking on other people's lawns. We also want to remind you that when your dog defecates weather on private or personal property it is your responsibility to clean up after them.

**Parking:** We would like to remind everyone that the alley ways located in the rear of the properties is narrow and parking your vehicle, so it overhangs the roadway is prohibited. Please be considerate of your neighbours and keep the roadway clear of obstructions.

**Community Hall Building Committee Fundraisers:** The Hall Committee has been working hard and it shows in the financial statement. The new Years Eve Cabaret earned \$8,000.00 in proceeds towards the new hall building and the Ladies night was even bigger earning \$14,000.00. **Water Valves:** Just a reminder that residents and privately hired plumbers are not allowed to use the Village water turn off valve located at the front of your property. **Recycle Bins:** The Village of Odessa would like to remind everyone of the wonderful grant we are participating in. We are granted money towards our garbage and recycling fees, according to the amount on tonnage we have picked up in our recycle bins.
